DESCRIPTION OF CLASSES

***102 OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY II** An airplane view of the Old Testament books from Job to Malachi.

***105 THE BIBLE AND WORLD MISSIONS** A survey of the history and practices of world missions, and the use of the Bible in missions.

***202 NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY II** An airplane view of the Pauline Epistles, General Epistles, and Revelation (Romans – Revelation).

***212 DOCTRINE II** A systematic study of the doctrines of angels, man, sin, and salvation.

500 SOTERIOLOGY A comprehensive study of the work of salvation in man. It covers every aspect of God's gracious work of salvation.

512 I & II TIMOTHY, TITUS A careful study of these three letters that highlights the organization and life of God's church.

513 MATTHEW This course deals with the major topics contained in this Jewish minded gospel. Special emphasis is given to the Sermon on the Mount, the making of disciples, and Christ's Second Coming.

***517 DISCIPLESHIP** The course is designed to stimulate a student's understanding of true Christian discipleship as taught by Jesus Christ.

519 PHILIPPIANS This course is a detailed study of Philippians, including the historical background and message of the book.

522 I PETER An analysis of First Peter that includes a study of introductory matters, interpretive problems, contents, and message.

527 I & II THESSALONIANS A study of these two letters and their relationship to eschatology, ecclesiology, and Christian living.

529 CHRISTOLOGY A study of the Person and Work of the Lord Jesus Christ that highlights His pre-existence, incarnation, earthly ministry, death, resurrection, and ascension.
